

Waynewood Recreation Association (WRA) Approved User (AU) Program 2011

The WRA is a member-based organization with 515 membership certificates available. Currently the wait for a membership certificate is estimated to be 3-4 years.

The WRA offers residents of the Waynewood subdivision an opportunity to utilize the WRA facilities and activities under a provisional program while they are on the waiting list for membership. **The Approved User agreement is not transferrable.** This means AU agreements may not be conveyed with the sale of a home or for any other reason.

The Approved User program requires the applicant to fill out an application for WRA membership. Once the application is received by the WRA the family will be added onto the waiting list for membership. Families who live within the Waynewood subdivision whom wish to participate in the AU program will be offered an annual contract. Essentially the contract requires a refundable deposit of $\frac{1}{2}$ the current value of the membership certificate, payment of the annual dues, payment of an annual administrative fee and an agreement that when a membership is offered the remaining $\frac{1}{2}$ of the current certificate value will be paid along with the new member fees.

WRA membership certificates are currently valued at \$600 so joining the AU program for 2011 would require a \$300 deposit, \$450 in dues and \$50 in administrative fees. If at some point you wish to drop out of the AU program you will be refunded your deposit and dues on a prorated basis. If a membership is offered and you decline to accept it and pay the balance of the certificate value and your new member fees the AU contract is immediately terminated and you are not eligible to rejoin under the AU program for 2 seasons.
